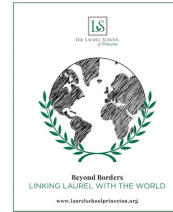


Walking for Water: Laurel School Walkathon



Water is a scarce resource in the arid regions of Uganda. Women and children walk an average of 6 kilometers or 3.7 miles to streams and ponds to collect small amounts of often contaminated water, making it the source of life-threatening illnesses.

The Laurel School Community will walk, jog, or run 6 kilometers (3.7 miles) around the school campus, as a fundraiser.

Why: The fundraising money enables the *Change a Life Uganda* organization to provide clean, running water and sanitation to the villagers in Migyera, Uganda.

Below is how fundraising money will be spent:

- Provide Ugandan students with WASH Team kits: **\$25**
- Supply the clay bricks to build a water purification system: **\$30**
- Test the filtered rainwater to see if it is safe to drink: **\$120**
- Supply the sand and cement to build a water purification system: **\$150**
- Supply a 1,500 Liter water harvesting tank to collect rainwater: **\$285**
- Build a toilet block (cement latrine): **\$1,200**
- Build a family both a water harvesting system and a water purification system: **\$2,000**

When: The Walking for Water Walkathon will be held on **Thursday, April 18, 2019** at the Laurel School of Princeton from **12:30 pm to 2:30 pm**.

Before: Collect Walkathon Pledges. Call, email, post or write family and friends to ask for their support. All Walkathon pledges and payments may be done online at:

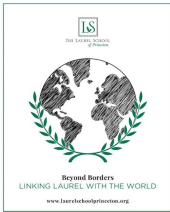
